- 1. Call to Order The meeting was called to order by Craig Barrett at 3:01 pm ET.
- 2. The agenda was adopted as presented.

Executive Director's Report: DeAnna Rowe provided an update on current funding developments in D.C., and informed the Board that the DC PCSB Charter Amendment Application had been moved to their board's June 2nd agenda. She also shared key insights regarding the recent U.S. Supreme Court decision concerning the Oklahoma religious charter school case, outlining its potential implications for charter schools nationally. Additionally, Ms. Rowe introduced the items included in the Consent Agenda.

- 7. Management Report: The BASIS Ed team presented the management report. Julie Kearney provided an enrollment update. Liz Greenberg provided a marketing update which was lauded by Craig for its high yields from a small budget. Calvery Cooper shared senior highlights and shared that graduation was set for June 6th. She also informed the board that BASIS DC was awarded the Summer Boost

Grant which would provide up to \$86k for a maximum of 90 students to participate in summer enrichment programming. Michelle Keogh discussed current and new complaints, with special education inquiries addressed by Katie Porter. Finally, Roberto Ramirez updated the board on the Annual Teacher Fund Campaign and shared details about the recent Supernova Gala.
